Lori was one of two therapists chosen to represent the United States in 1991 at the First Symposium of Physiotherapists and Riding Instructors which took place in Surry, England. Lori has trained successfully up to Fourth Level Dressage and is a lifelong horsewoman. She also helped develop, as Clinical Director at SDTC, The Center for Discovery's, Milligan Hill Equine Assisted Therapy and Activity Program and in 2005-2007, Lori served as Interim Executive Director and Program Director at The National Center for Equine Facilitated Therapy. In 2010 she was awarded the prestigious Oyster Bay, New York, 2010 Woman of the Year Award for her work in the Health Industry and promoting Hippotherapy. In 2013 she was awarded the lifelong achievement award of the AHA Barbara Glasow Therapist of the Year Award. She has a private practice on Long Island, New York since 1990, Physical Therapy In Motion, and incorporates Hippotherapy, NDT, Myofascial, Kinesio Tape, Cranial Sacral and Astronaut Training into her patient's plan of care.

Horse Connection

This 2 and a half day advanced level hands-on course/clinic is designed for the horse handler involved in OT, PT or Speech Therapy treatment integrating hippotherapy into the plan of care. As well as the equine professional or owner interested in learning how to teach a horse to long line, specific to the purpose of a treatment session. The horse handler can be a PATH Intl. Certified Processional/Instructor, equine specialist, horse trainer, therapists or volunteer who is part of the hippotherapy team or horse person who has basic lunging and ground skills.

Course Objectives:

- Demonstrate a thorough knowledge of all safety aspects of lunging and long lining.
- Demonstrate a clear understanding of the fit, care and application of all the equipment.
- Ability to produce quality movement on straight lines and school figures when long lining.
- Demonstrate ability to grade movement at the walk on ling lines.
- Understand the concept of a starting a horse.
- Understand the principles of alternative leading methods.
- Demonstrate the ability to teach a novice person to correctly lead a horse for a session in which hippotherapy is incorporated.

The curriculum may be utilized only under the conditions set forth by AHA, Inc.

This course is run more like a clinic, classroom time is limited, and all materials are sent to the attendees electronically prior to the course. Course fees include breakfast and lunch. During the course you will be working directly with and around horses. Please have appropriate clothing/footwear. Helmets will be provided as needed. Indicate any special restrictions on the registration form.

Intended Audience: Occupational therapists, Physical therapist, and Speech Language Pathologists interested in starting up a private practice incorporating hippotherapy. Administrators of equine assisted activities programs looking to add/grow services by partnering with OT, PT and SLP professionals or starting a therapy/medical model business/branch.
