The grand finale for CES students' Project Based Learning experience was on May 26th when Gnomeo made a surprise visit to thank all 120 **Countryside Elementary School** first graders for their support!

The first-grade team received a grant from the **Loudoun Education Foundation** to partner with LTR to explore how what they were learning in their economics unit applied within our programs. During this school year, students studied: needs, wants, producers, consumers, goods, services, persuasive writing (does Gnomeo need or want treats?), spending and saving. Through interactive lessons, students officially made "shopping" lists that covered many items the LTR herd needs/wants, which made learning fun with real life applications. Teachers made the purchases which were captured on video, and shown to the kids in the classroom!
